MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

Health Care Coverage for:

- Age 65 or older
- Blind or Disabled
- Children Under 19
- Pregnant Women
- Parents of Minor Children
- Relative Caretakers of Minor Children

The Economic Support Unit determines eligibility for many categories of Medical Assistance known by the following names;

- BadgerCare Plus
- Medical Assistance
- MA
- Medicaid
- Healthy Start
- BadgerCare
- Title 19
- Medicaid Purchase Plan (MAPP)
- Forward Card
- FPW (Family Planning Waiver)

Income limits range from 85% to 250% of Federal Poverty.

Asset Limits range from \$1,000 to \$15,000 with several categories with NO asset limit.

An Employment Program for:

- Custodial parent of minor children
- Non-custodial parent of W-2 children
- Minor Custodial Parents
- Pregnant Women

W-2 Offers:

- * Case Management Services
- * Employment & Training Services
- * Financial Assistance

TIME LIMITED BENEFITS

CHILD CARE

Payment Assistance for:

Children under 13 years in regulated care while parent(s);
* work
* attend school
* participate in W2

Requires Co-Payment based on household income, hours and cost of care.

Nutrition Benefits for:

- Individuals or families except those;
- Disqualified for Fraud
- Voluntarily Quit Job
- Strikers and Families
- Students in higher education unless exempt
- Non-citizens unless exempt

ENERGY ASSISTANCE

Heating & Utility Assistance for:

- Annual One Time Heating/Energy Grant
- Crisis Assistance (households w/o heat)
- Emergency Pro-Active (prevent disconnections)
- Furnace Repair / Replacement
- Weatherization Services

BADGERCARE + CORE PLAN

Medical Assistance for:

- Individuals age 19-64
- Wisconsin Residents
- Do NOT have minor children Living with you
- Are not pregnant
- Family income less than 200% FPL
- Do/did not have private insurance
- \$60 non-refundable application fee

HOUSING ASSISTANCE

Emergency Assistance for:

- Victims of Natural Disaster; (Fire, Flood, etc.)
- Homeless and potentially homeless families who have been or are being evicted, are in a shelter or whose home is uninhabitable.

MEDICARE BENEFICIARY

Assistance for:

Elderly & disabled individuals who have Medicare. Program helps pay all or portions of Medicare deductible or monthly premiums based on gross monthly income limits.
